



Nicholas Chohey Scholarship Program

THE PROGRAM

Chemical Engineering Magazine has established a scholarship program to assist students who plan to continue their education in college programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at one of five eligible four-year institutions.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship America®, the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship, tuition assistance and other education support programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Nicholas Chohey Scholarship Program must be current third-year students who are enrolled in full-time undergraduate study in Chemical Engineering at one of the following four-year colleges or universities for the entire upcoming academic year:

- Columbia University,
- Rutgers University,
- SUNY Buffalo,
- University of Kansas,
- University of Oklahoma,
- University of Virginia

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a one-time only award that may be used for undergraduate study only.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship America postmarked no later than **April 16**. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment email is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship America to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship America.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship America. In no instance does any officer or employee of *Chemical Engineering Magazine* play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Applicants will be notified in late May. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship America processes Nicholas Chohey Scholarship payments on behalf of *Chemical Engineering Magazine*. Payments are made in one installment on August 1.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to *Chemical Engineering Magazine*. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship America of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

REVISIONS

Chemical Engineering Magazine reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
